Dear Parents and Guardians,

We are delighted to share with you the plan for Activity Week 2025! This exciting event will take place from Wednesday, 16th July, through to Tuesday, 22nd July. We have a fantastic lineup of activities planned to ensure the students have an enjoyable and memorable experience.

Activity Schedule:

Wednesday, 16th July – Rare Breeds Centre

Students will have the opportunity to meet and interact with a variety of traditional rare breed animals, including cattle, sheep, pigs, horses, and poultry. The centre features an exotic butterfly tunnel, discovery garden, woodland walks, play areas, a maze, and pig racing.

Thursday, 17th July – Wingham Wildlife Park

A day at the zoo where students can see animals such as giraffes, penguins, monkeys, lions, and tigers. There are animal walkways for up-close encounters, an outdoor museum, play area, and sensory gardens.

Friday, 18th July – Climbing and Inflatable Fun

In the morning, students will visit Clip and Climb in Maidstone to try different climbing walls and participate in adventurous activities under full instructor supervision. In the afternoon, they will go to Jump In Fun in Rochester to enjoy inflatable assault courses and burn off some energy. Please note that students should wear sportswear on this day, as jeans and non-sport shoes are not suitable for activities.

Students will spend the day in Margate, enjoying crabbing, beach time, visiting the amusement park and arcades, and exploring an art gallery.
