Dear parents & carers,

A warm welcome back to all our students, families, and staff! Term 1 has got off to a fantastic start, full of learning, engagement, and new experiences.

Fridays have been a highlight, with students enjoying bowling and taking part in our Friday carousel at MidKent College. This term focused on *Animal Management*, giving students hands-on experience caring for animals, exploring the college environment, building confidence, and trying areas of learning they might not otherwise encounter. Next term, the carousel will move on to *Hair and Beauty*.

We've also launched a new *Learning Outside the Classroom experience* at Larkin Farm, Abbey Court School in Strood, where students have been feeding and caring for animals such as rabbits and chickens, learning teamwork and responsibility along the way.
