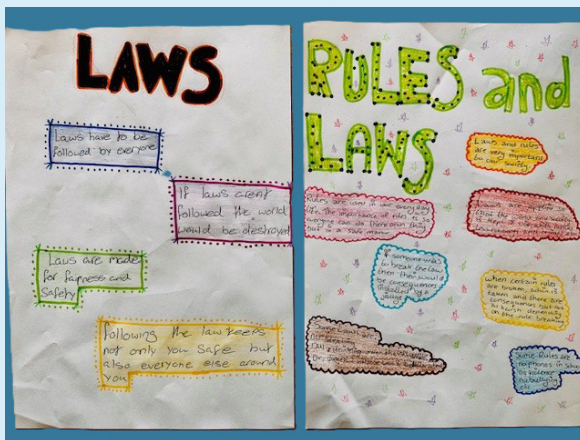
# Highlights Reel - Term 4 - 2025/2026
