**Re: Activity Week 13<sup>th</sup> – 17<sup>th</sup> July**

We are delighted to share with you the plan for Activity Week 2026! This exciting event will take place from Monday the 13<sup>th</sup> to Friday the 17<sup>th</sup> of July. We have a fantastic lineup of activities planned to ensure the students have an enjoyable and memorable experience.

**Activity Schedule:**

**Monday 13<sup>th</sup> July: Greenwich Observatory, Cutty Sark and Greenwich Park**

During an action-packed day in Greenwich, students will explore space science, geographic discovery, and British history across three iconic locations. They will begin at the Royal Observatory to journey through the planetarium, see the historic marine clocks, and stand on the famous Prime Meridian Line. Next, they will head into Greenwich Park to explore its historic green spaces, take in the London skyline, and enjoy an open-air picnic lunch. Finally, they will visit the Cutty Sark.

**Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> July: Herne Bay Pier, Amusement Arcades and Crabbing**

Students will head to the classic seaside town of Herne Bay for a traditional coastal adventure. Throughout the day, they will try their hand at crabbing along the bustling pier, enjoy games and rides at the beachfront amusement park and vibrant family arcades, and spend plenty of time relaxing and exploring on the beach.

**Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> July – Pizza Making Experience at Pizza Express and Laser Tag**

During the morning session, students will enjoy a hands on culinary masterclass at Pizza Express. They will learn kitchen safety, prepare their own pizza bases, and add their toppings. While their creations bake, the class will participate in a sensory tasting quiz before sitting down together to eat their handmade lunch and collect a commemorative certificate. In the afternoon, students will enjoy laser tag.

**Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> July – Royal Engineers Museum & Archery**

In the morning, students will visit the Royal Engineers Museum to see real world STEM concepts in action. They will experience a life-sized World War I trench replica, stand beneath an authentic Harrier Jump Jet, and examine a massive German V2 rocket. While moving through the galleries, they will complete



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interactive trails and analyse historical treasures, such as a fragment of the Berlin Wall. In the afternoon, students will take part in an outdoor archery session where they will learn safe bow handling, practise their aim on the targets, and develop their precision and focus.

### **Friday 17<sup>th</sup> July – Park Day and Celebration**

Students will kick off the day at a local park, coming together to build team spirit through a series of energetic games and outdoor activities. In the afternoon, the festivities will shift back to school for a celebratory BBQ. This special gathering will give the whole school community a chance to relax, share food, and celebrate the achievements of our departing students as we send them off with our best wishes on their transition to pastures new.

### **Please note:**

- Students will need a packed lunch on Monday, Tuesday and Thursday. On Wednesday, they will have their pizzas from the Pizza making experience, and then on Friday, lunch will be provided at school.
- Students are welcome to bring spending money for drinks and snacks.
- The total cost for the week is £60, which covers all activities, transportation, and insurance.
- Students must attend all days, as the cost is non-refundable and attendance cannot be selective.
- Payment should be made in full by Friday, 26<sup>th</sup> June to help us confirm final arrangements.

If your child will not be attending the offsite activities for Activity Week, they are required to come into school during these dates for our alternative timetabled sessions.
